Foundation 2	<p>Identify pictures on speed sound cards.</p> <p>Revise the Set 1 sounds speedily (then Set 2).</p> <p>Make words and blend to read using Set 1 sounds.</p> <p>Practise reading the green story words, speedy green words or red words from Read Write Inc. books.</p> <p>Read Ditty Sheets or Read Write Inc. Storybooks.</p> <p>Listen to books being read aloud by a grown up. Key Stage 1 (Key Stage 2 pupils on the Read Write Inc. Phonics programme.)	<p>Revise the Set 1, 2 and 3 sounds speedily.</p> <p>Practise reading the green story words, speedy green words or red words from Read Write Inc.</p> <p>Read Ditty Sheets or Read Write Inc. Storybooks.</p> <p>Share books which they may not yet be able to read independently from home or school ('Share at home' books or school library texts).</p> <p>Listen to books being read aloud by a grown up. Discuss new vocabulary and join in with repeated rhythms or rhyming words.</p> <p>Read e-books on Oxford Owl together.</p> <p>Read real and nonsense words on resources provided by school or on online games.</p>	<p>Read Write Inc. Key Stage 2 (Key Stage 1 pupils who have completed the Read Write Inc. Programme.)	<p>Encourage your child to read the Wirral to the World levelled passport books they choose from school .
