Ideas For Helping Your Child At Home



- Point out colours and shapes; ask your child to point them out to you, this can be in the shops, in the car, anywhere!
- Count aloud! Forwards and backwards.
- Practise holding and using scissors; give children old magazines or papers to cut.
- Practise 'self-help skills'; encourage your child to dress and undress themselves, **put on and fasten their own coat.**
