

Raeburn Primary School Uniform Policy

For Whole School including Early Years Foundation Stage

The smart appearance of our pupils reflects our high standards and the pride we all have in our school.

The uniform at Raeburn Primary is:

- Navy or pale blue sweatshirt or cardigan with the school emblem
- White or pale blue polo shirt, either with or without the school emblem
- Grey or black trousers or shorts OR
- Grey or navy skirt or pinafore dress
- White socks with a skirt
- Black, navy or grey tights
- Black or grey socks with trousers or shorts
- Flat black shoes no trainers
- Sensible black boots may be worn during very cold periods
- A blue checked or striped summer dress may be worn during the summer term
- No make-up or nail varnish

Hair:

- Long hair MUST be fully tied back
- Hair accessories should be either black, grey, blue or white and should be of a reasonable size
- Short hair should have an appropriate, 'sensible' cut

Jewellery:

- From Year 1 upwards one analogue watch may be worn OR
- One digital watch may be worn but it must NOT have direct access to the internet OR be able to take photographic images
- One pair of plain stud earrings may be worn, these must be removed at home on PE days
- No other jewellery should be worn

PE:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Black or blue shorts and/or jogging trousers
- Black or white trainers or pumps
- Black or blue long sleeve sweatshirt for colder weather

Bags:

Raeburn book bag

Digital technology:

We strongly advise against children bringing digital devices into school for safeguarding reasons, however where it is necessary to have them in school, children should hand their device in to the school office at the beginning of the day. They must then collect it at the end of the day.
